




## *Project Description*

- slender, powerful, deeply descended voice









### White tailed deer

- medium sized, located in the US
- widely distributed in the Rockies
- coat is reddish-brown during summer, turns to gray-brown during winter
- males known as bucks + song
- males regrow their antlers every year
- length + branching of antlers depends on nutrition, age + genetics
- older deer have larger snouts + grayer coats
- antlers begin to grow in late spring, covered with "velvet" and are rather symmetrical.
- bucks shed antlers from late December - Feb
- very adaptable to different habitats
- eat legumes, shrubs, leaves, grasses, fruit
- 4 chambered stomach
- predators are wolves, coyotes - chase + ambush
- max speed approx 40mph
- competitive mating for females... "rutting season"
- females give birth to 1-3 spotted fawns
- raises white tail when warning others.
